foreword

In the name of Allah, the Beneficent the Merciful I bear witness that there is no God but Allah and Muhammad is the final Messenger of Allah.

The best among you are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it (to others). (Bukhari)

Reading Qur'an is the first step towards fulfilling the rights of the Qur'an. It is important that we read the Qur'an in the best possible manner in order to please Allah . The Prophet Muhammad said: "One who is proficient in the Qur'an is going to be associated with the honorable Angels, and those who read but falter in it and find it difficult will have a double reward. Hence, beautify the Qur'an with your voices." (Bukhari)

The art of reading the Qur'an correctly is called Tajweed. It literally means "elocution", and describes the correct pronunciation of the Arabic letters with all their attributes. We must understand that Arabic is a nuanced language; even a slight variation in pronunciation can drastically alter the meaning of a word. For example: " سُعُنِهُ " means heart, and " عَلِيمُ " means dog; similarly, " مُعْلِيمُ " means knowledgeable and " الله " means painful. Though the words sound similar, but the two sets of meanings are completely different.

Tajweed is important. An extra effort is needed to ensure that the delivery of each word is precise. Just as we might get upset if someone doesn't pronounce our name correctly, Allah also expects precision from us when reading His words.

Let us try to be the best in reading the Qur'an, so that it can bear witness to our efforts on the Day of Judgment. May Allah give us the opportunity to be the best students and teachers of the Qur'an. Aameen.

I thank Allah for giving us the opportunity to serve the Qur'an and I thank Brother Muhammad Billal Siddiqui in helping and preparing this book for the Ummah. May Allah accept this work from us and make it a Sadaqah Jariyah for all of us In Shaa' Allah.

Teaching Method and Techniques

- 1 Students are our responsibility. If they learn Qur'an properly, they will be a continuous source of blessings and a Sadaqah Jariyah for us.
- 2 Use **Talgeen** method throughout the book. **Talgeen** method (teacher reads and student repeats) is the best known method to develop proper pronunciation and fluency in the reading.
- 3 Fluency must be developed from this book; otherwise students will be slow readers of the Qur'an.
- The following must be adopted on the part of the students: **listening**, **repeating** and **reading**.
- Make the students memorize all fat letters (in one breath), all throat letters (in one breath), all letters (in two breaths), the source of sound (Makhraj) of each letter and the letters in groups.
- 6 Maintain a uniform practice as a standard throughout the book in order to get the best results. Students must be readina:
 - Each letter / word 10 times
 - Each line forward 10 times (in one breath)
 - Each line backward 10 times (in one breath)
- Do not allow the students to proceed to the next lesson/page until they fully master their Makharij / pronunciation and apply all rules of Tajweed.
- 8 Constant revision is important and it should be a part of daily routine. Different methods can be used for this purpose: 1) daily revision of 5 most recent pages;
 - 2) revision practice over the weekend; 3) using quizzes to test the rules of Tajweed;
 - 4) test after every lesson; and, 5) getting the parents involved.
- Take a detailed test after page 14, 44, and 60. The tests can be downloaded from www.tajweedmadeeasy.com
- 10 You may use prizes and candies for excellent performance, as a way to motivate the students.
- Concentration and discipline in the class is important. The teacher should have full control of the class in order to provide the best learning environment and transfer maximum benefit to the students.
- Always make Dua for your students and for yourself for the acceptance of your effort.

Marking and Fixing Mistakes



It is important for a teacher to mark all mistakes to improve the quality of Tajweed and this should not be compromised at all. Precise marking is more effective in showing the exact problem instead of marking the entire word, so students can clearly see their mistakes and fix them without any confusion. This way, the students can correct their own mistakes and improve faster.

Here are a few examples of precise marking:

1- If a student stretches a short vowel, circle only the "Short Vowel".












2- If a student does not extend a Madd letter, then circle only the "Madd Letter".












3- If a student does not apply the following signs properly: Sukoon, Shaddah or Madd, then circle the "**Sign**" only.











4- If a student is making Qalqalah on the sukoon of Laam or Noon, then circle the **"Sukoon"** only.











5- If a student makes a mistake for the first time, circle that mistake: المنافذة If a student makes the same mistake for the second time, underline that mistake: المنافذة If a student still makes the same mistake for the third time, then make him / her fix it in front of you by repeating it as many times as is necessary.

Learning Method and Techniques

Do you want to learn Qur'an? Then, learn it and read it the way Allah ****** wants to hear, not the way you want to read. The Prophet Muhammad ****** said: "The best among you are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it (to others)". (Bukhari)

Al-Hamdulillah, you are learning to read the Qur'an with proper Tajweed, so you are very special and beloved to Allah so much so that Prophet Muhammad so said that the birds in the sky, fish in the water, and insects of the earth make Dua for the student of knowledge. (Abu Dawood)

Remember the following:

- n Read Qur'an the way Allah wants to hear it, not the way you want to read.
- 2 For each letter that you are reading, you are getting 10 rewards from Allah ...
- 3 Respect this book because it contains words from the Qur'an.
- 4 Half of the knowledge is granted by respecting the teacher and the book.

 Make your best effort for the other half.
- 5 Listen to your teacher and follow the instructions.
- 6 Follow the instructions on each page to get the best results.
- Get all your senses involved, look at the book and put your finger on the letter / word.
- 8 Always read out loud, in order to have a clear pronunciation.
- Revision of the most recent 5 pages should be done on a daily basis.
- (1) Ask questions if you do not understand something.
- Dedicate some time to practice your lessons at home.
- Make Dua for your success.



Makharij is the plural of Makhraj, which means the point of articulation, pronunciation or a place where the letter comes from.

There are 29 letters in Arabic, seven of them are pronounced fat and full mouth with elevating the tongue: خ ص ض ط ظ غ ق, they are called الحروف المفخَّمة (the fat letters) or الحروف المستعلِيّة (the elevated letters).

There are six throat letters خ خ خ خ خ خ م and they are called الحروف الحلقية (the throat letters).

It is very important for students to know the difference between the Arabic letters. Sometimes the students start learning from Alif to Yaa, this way the students will not have a clear understanding of the Makharij and Sifaat of these letters. The following is the suggested order in which the students should learn the Alphabet: (1st) Fat letters (2nd) Throat Letters (3rd) All Letters.


















When Noon Kasrah $\dot{\mathcal{Q}}$ is added to replace Tanween $\frac{\mathfrak{G}_{\mathscr{P}}}{\mathscr{P}}$ with a single vowel $\frac{\mathfrak{G}_{\mathscr{P}}}{\mathscr{P}}$ and joined with the following Sukoon or Shaddah $\frac{\mathfrak{G}_{\mathscr{P}}}{\mathscr{P}}$, then this rule is applied.

Hamzatul wasl found in between the two words will remain silent.

أحكام الوقف

Waqf means "to stop". The following explains some of the rules of Waqf, where and how to stop on a word:

- (1) If there is Fathah, Kasrah, Dhammah, two Kasrah or two Dhammah on the last letter, it will be read with Sukoon when you stop.
- (2) If there are two Fathah on the last letter, it will be changed to one Fathah and read with Alif.
- (3) If there is a Shaddah on the last letter, emphasis on the letter without a vowel.
- (4) If there is a round Taa at the end of a word $\frac{\delta}{\delta}$, it will be changed to Haa $\frac{\delta}{\delta}$ when you stop.
- (5) Small Noon (ن) will not be applied, when you stop on the word before Shaddah or Sukoon.




